Description

Be in charge of the Counselor in Training (CIT) program at camp, overseeing both the CIT1s and CIT2s. Be on the camp leadership team with the other activity directors.

Qualifications

Minimum 21 years of age

Experience in leadership and working with youth, specifically teens

Desire to work with children in an outdoor setting

Ability to work with and supervise peers

Ability to take guidance and supervision

Must have good character, integrity, physical and mental health, adaptability, enthusiasm, patience

Responsibilities

Be a leader/counselor for the CIT1s

- Set up the CIT House during staff training

- Live in the CIT House with the CIT1s during camp

- Set and enforce the house rules, including cleaning guidelines

- Complete an activity report at the end of the summer

Lead the CIT leadership program

- Prepare written lesson plans for the 3 week long CIT leadership program

- Help CITs plan their special events- banquet, bark boats, night program, camp service project, etc.

- Assist the CITs in running the camp store with the Office Manager

- Evaluate each CIT1

Be in charge of the CIT2s

- Help with conducting a CIT2 training prior to camp

- Meet with the CIT2s each day to discuss their responsibilities

- Organize a graduation for the CIT2s at the end of their 3 weeks

- Evaluate each CIT2

As a member of the Leadership Team, the following is expected

- Conduct yourself as a role model for cabin counselors

- Be a part of planning and carrying out special programming

- Assist with duties assigned to the Leadership Team

- Be a driver for off-site trips (not required)

- Participate in all night programs, meals, and camp events
