Job Description

Be in charge of the outdoor living skills (OLS) program at camp. Teach OLS classes and coordinate camping trips for the Advanced OLS class. Be in charge of the camp wide campout each session. Be on the camp leadership team with the other activity directors.

Qualifications

Minimum 21 years of age

Experience in hiking, camping, outdoor education, etc.

Ability to teach outdoor living skills to campers of all ages in an engaging way

Current First Aid/CPR certifications. Lifeguard certification preferred.

Desire to work with children in an outdoor setting

Ability to work with and supervise peers

Ability to take guidance and supervision

Must have good character, integrity, physical and mental health, adaptability, enthusiasm, patience

Responsibilities

Lead OLS activities on a daily basis

- Have written lesson plans for two week sessions

- Plan activities based on age and skill of campers

- Have activities that engage and educate the campers

- Train staff that will be assisting in OLS classes

- Complete an activity report at the end of the summer

Coordinate camping trips

- This includes Advanced OLS camping trip and on-site campout

Be in charge of OLS equipment

- Teach proper use of equipment to campers

- Set up the OLS area during staff training

- Keep equipment in good condition

- File repairs needed

- Conduct an inventory at the end of the summer

- Pack materials at the end of the summer

As a member of the Leadership Team, the following is expected

- Live with other members of the Leadership Team

- Conduct yourself as a role model for cabin counselors

- Be a part of planning and carrying out special programming

- Assist with duties assigned to the Leadership Team

- Be a driver for off-site trips (not required)

- Participate in all night programs, meals, and camp events
